The First Easter

April comes with the high days of the church calendar, including the Holy Week and Easter Sunday. We will hold a Good Friday Service on the 14th that includes meditations on Stations of the Cross; an Easter Sunrise Service on the 16th at Old Field Point, Moon; and our Easter service will be at 10 o'clock.

It is a beautiful coincidence that Easter comes in the spring, since every spring is a resurrection of sort. The frozen earth gives way to new life, and the tree branches bud green leaves. It even prompted some to claim that Easter was originated from spring festivals!


