#### **New Prayer Study**

Prayer is one of the most important practices in our Christian faith. Prayer connects us with God and one another, keeps us balanced and Christ-centered in uncertain times, and enables us to know what direction to go as we move into the future. Come and learn more about this special prayer journey (described below) on **Saturday morning**, **September 13, at 9:30 a.m. at the parsonage**.

We are offering a new online (At-homeoption) or In-class-option resource this fall: **Exploring Contemplative Prayer: A Nine Month Journey to the Quiet.** This course, created and published by Scripture Echo, will introduce you to eight different prayer practices over the course of nine months. This online resource is offered from **September 2014 - May 2015**, however, you may join at any time and do not need to start from the beginning.

What to expect: On the first day of each month you will receive an introductory email and online access to a PDF document that contains 1) a welcome letter, 2) background (history & theology) of the prayer practice, 3) a step-by-step guide for experiencing the prayer practice, 4) suggestions for exploring the prayer practice, and 5) a journal for that month.

#### <u>Cost:</u> \$10

The course is designed to help us slow down, relax at the feet of God, and absorb the love, grace and wisdom that are waiting for us there. We hope you will take advantage of this resource.
